PROCLAMATION NUMBER 19 JBE 2017

SPECIAL ELECTION – CHIEF OF POLICE, VILLAGE OF EAST HODGE, PARISH OF JACKSON

WHEREAS, a vacancy exists in the office of Chief of Police, Village of East Hodge, Parish of Jackson, due to the death of Simmie T. “Slim” Brown on September 8, 2016; and

WHEREAS, Louisiana Revised Statutes 18:602 authorizes the Governor to call a special election to fill the vacancy in an office of a member of a parish or municipal governing authority when the remaining term exceeds eighteen (18) months, in accordance with the provisions of La. R.S. 18:602 and/or the dates for elections set forth in La. R.S. 18:402.

NOW THEREFORE, I, JOHN BEL EDWARDS, Governor of the State of Louisiana, by virtue of the authority vested by the Constitution and the laws of the State of Louisiana, do hereby order and direct as follows:

SECTION 1: A special primary and a special general election shall be held throughout the jurisdiction of the Village of East Hodge, Parish of Jackson, for the purpose of electing a chief of police to fill the vacancy in the office.

SECTION 2: Any qualified person desiring to become a candidate for the office shall file a notice of candidacy, accompanied either by a qualifying fee or a nominating petition, as required or authorized by law, with the appropriate election official in the manner and form, and under the procedures and conditions, provided by La. R.S. 18:461 *et seq.*, and all other applicable provisions of the Louisiana Election Code, La. R.S. 18:1 *et seq.*, during the period commencing Wednesday, July 12, 2017, and ending at 4:30 p.m. Friday, July 14, 2017.

SECTION 3: The special election shall be held and conducted under the applicable provisions of the Louisiana Election Code, La. R.S. 18:1 *et seq.*

SECTION 4: The primary election shall be held Saturday, October 14, 2017, and the general election shall be held Saturday, November 18, 2017, at the times and places and in the manner, prescribed by law.

SECTION 5: The Secretary of State, Commissioner of Elections, Parish Board of Election Supervisors, Clerk of Court, Registrar of Voters, and all other persons charged with any power, function, right, duty or responsibility in conducting elections in the jurisdiction of the Village of East Hodge, Parish of Jackson, are hereby authorized, requested, directed and empowered to exercise every lawful function and to do every act necessary to conduct the special election, to cause the returns to be made, to canvass and promulgate the results, and to perform all related and incidental functions.
