

**Residents should enter the collection site from Corbin Ave (Hwy 1029) onto Ball Park Rd at the North end**

## Materials Accepted

Acids	Used Oils
Aerosols	Mercury
Batteries (except NiCad)	Helium
Flammable Liquids	Lead
Fluorescent Bulbs	Oxidizers
Flammable Solids	
Tires (limit: 5 per household)	
Prescription Medications	
Paint (Oil and Latex)	
Pesticides/Herbicides	
Propane Cylinders (5 & 10 gal only)	
Electronics (TVs, Computers, etc.)	
Small Fire Extinguishers (2 ft or less in length)	

## Materials NOT Accepted

Fireworks
Non-residential Waste
Radioactive Devices (smoke/fire detectors)
Construction/Demolition Debris
School Lab Waste
Fire Extinguishers (over 2 ft in length)
Appliances (Refrigerators, Microwaves, etc.)
Furniture
Power Tools
Medical Waste
Insulation
Propane Cylinders (anything over 5 gal)
Gas Cylinders (oxygen, acetylene, etc.)
