

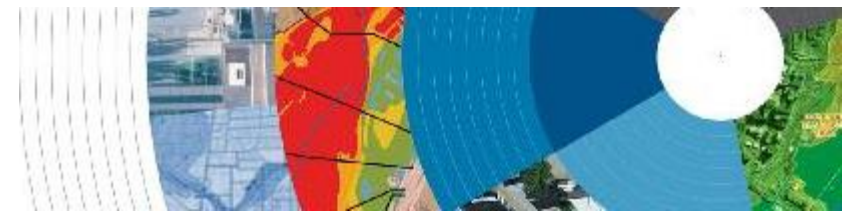

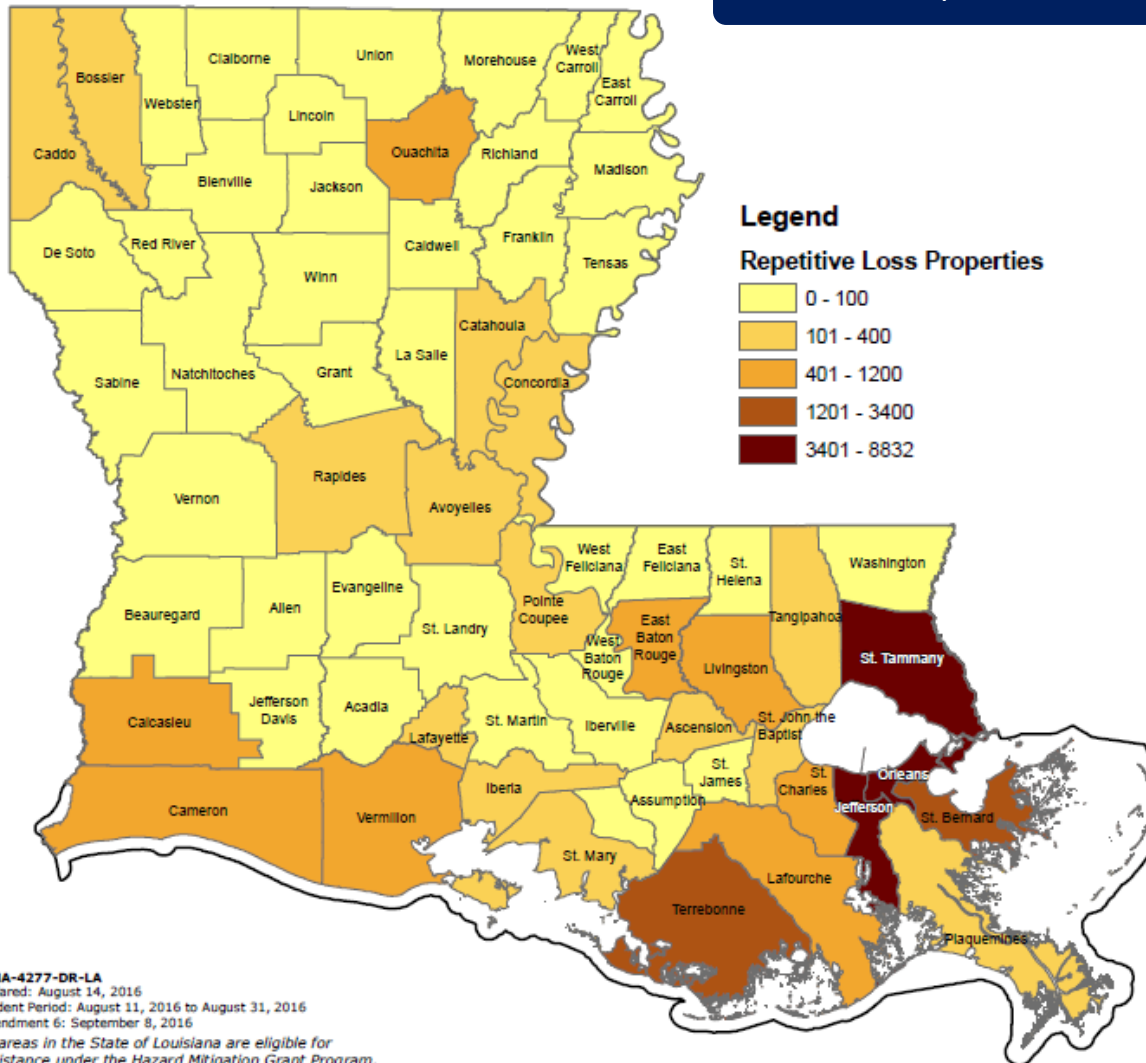
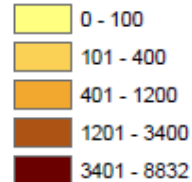

Two or more claims more than \$1000 paid by NFIP within any rolling 10 year period

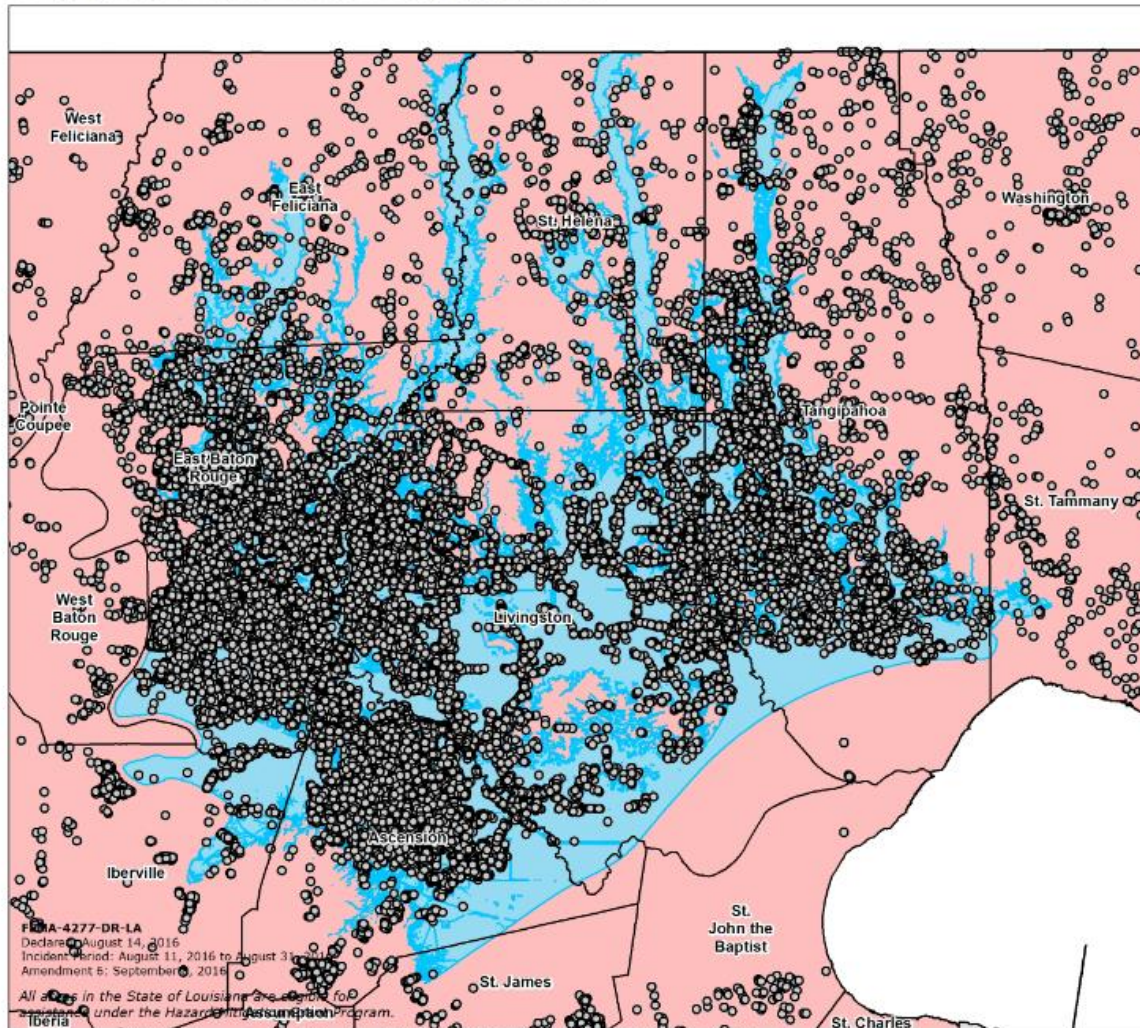
Severe Repetitive Loss Property

- (a) Four NFIP claim payments (including building and contents) over \$5,000 each, and the cumulative amount of such claims payments exceeds \$20,000;
- (b) Two separate claims payments (building payments only) have been made with the cumulative amount of the building portion of such claims exceeding the market value of the building.

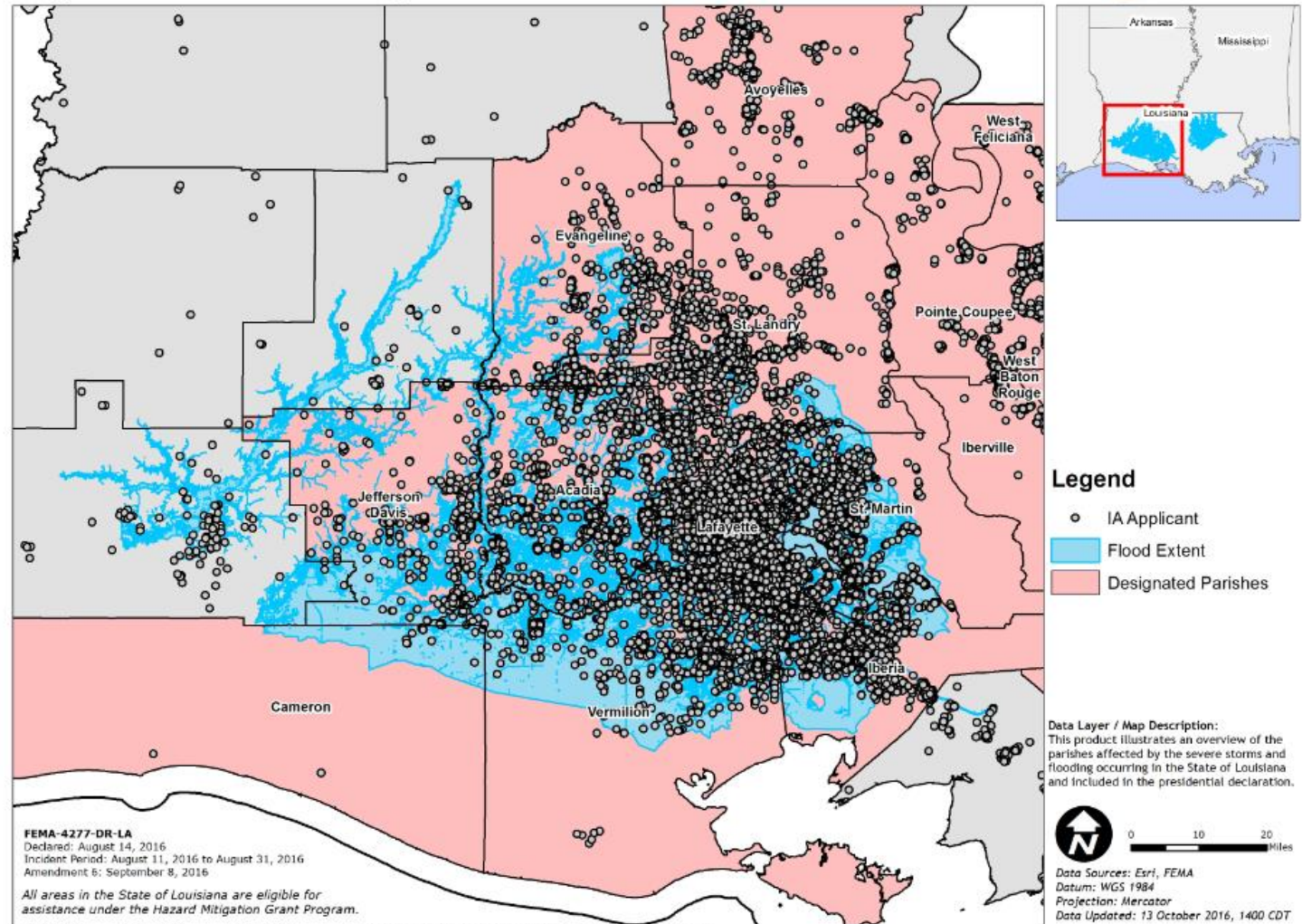

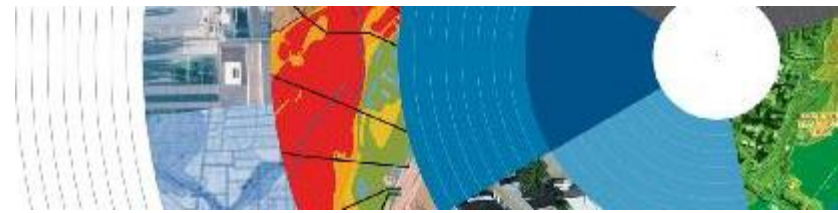
