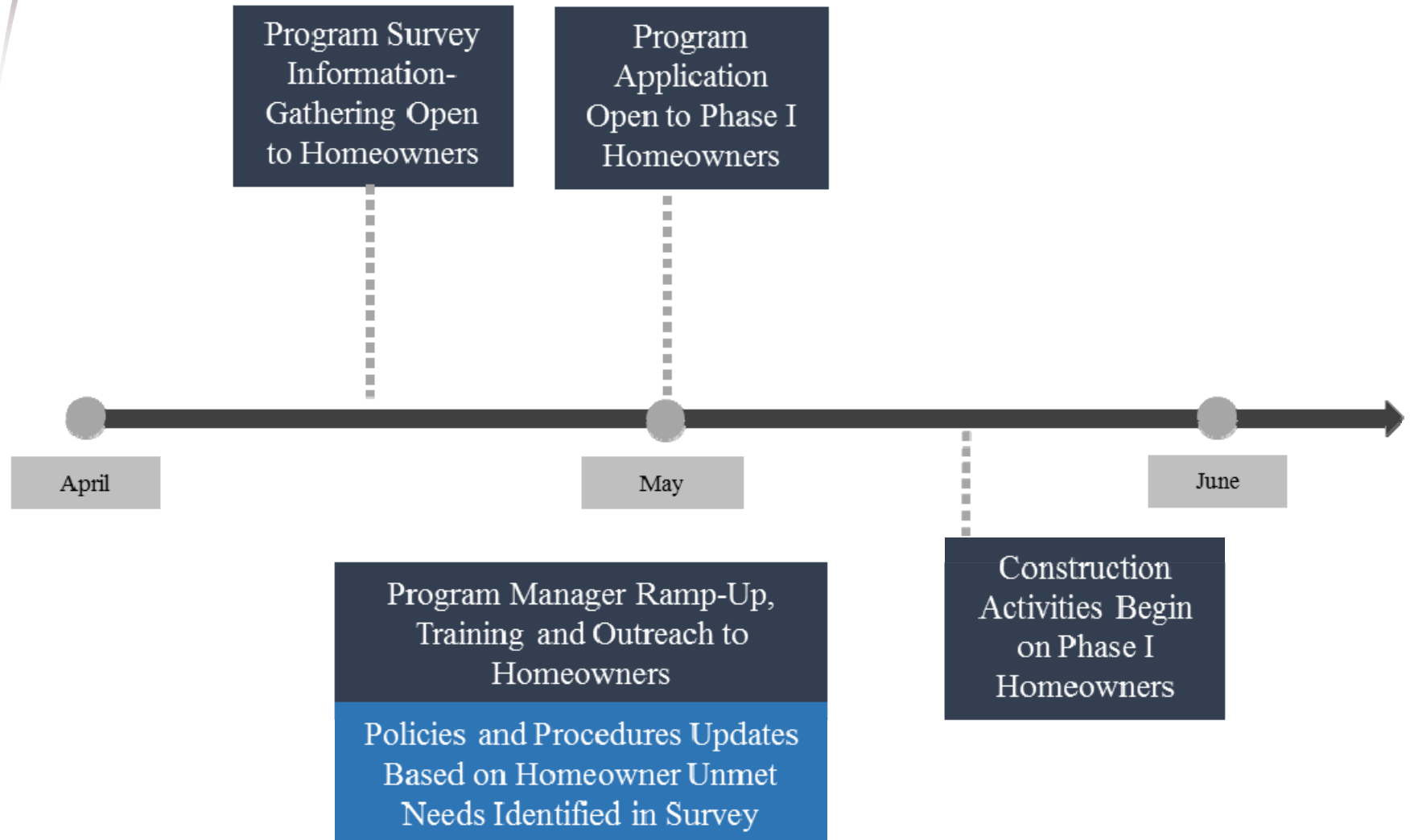

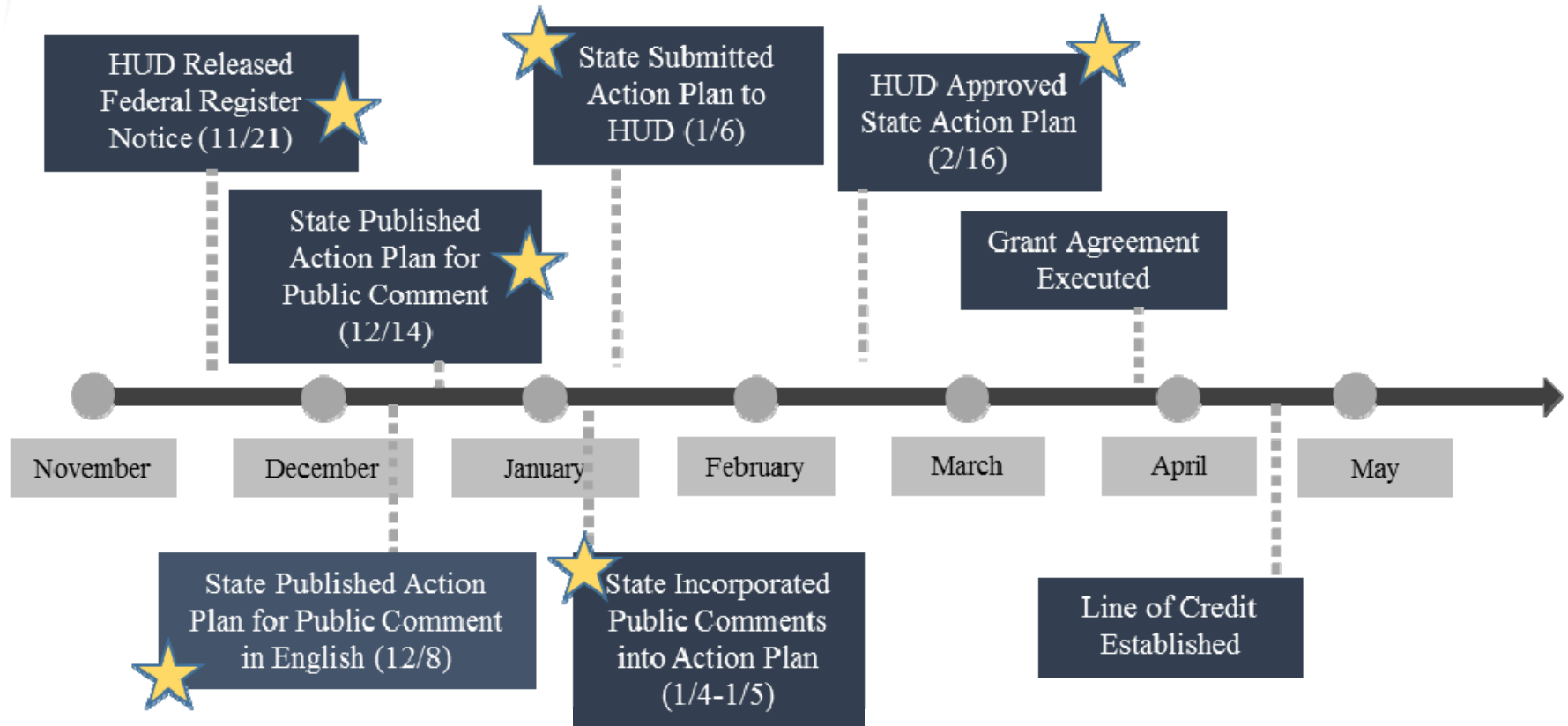


Homeowner Program Implementation



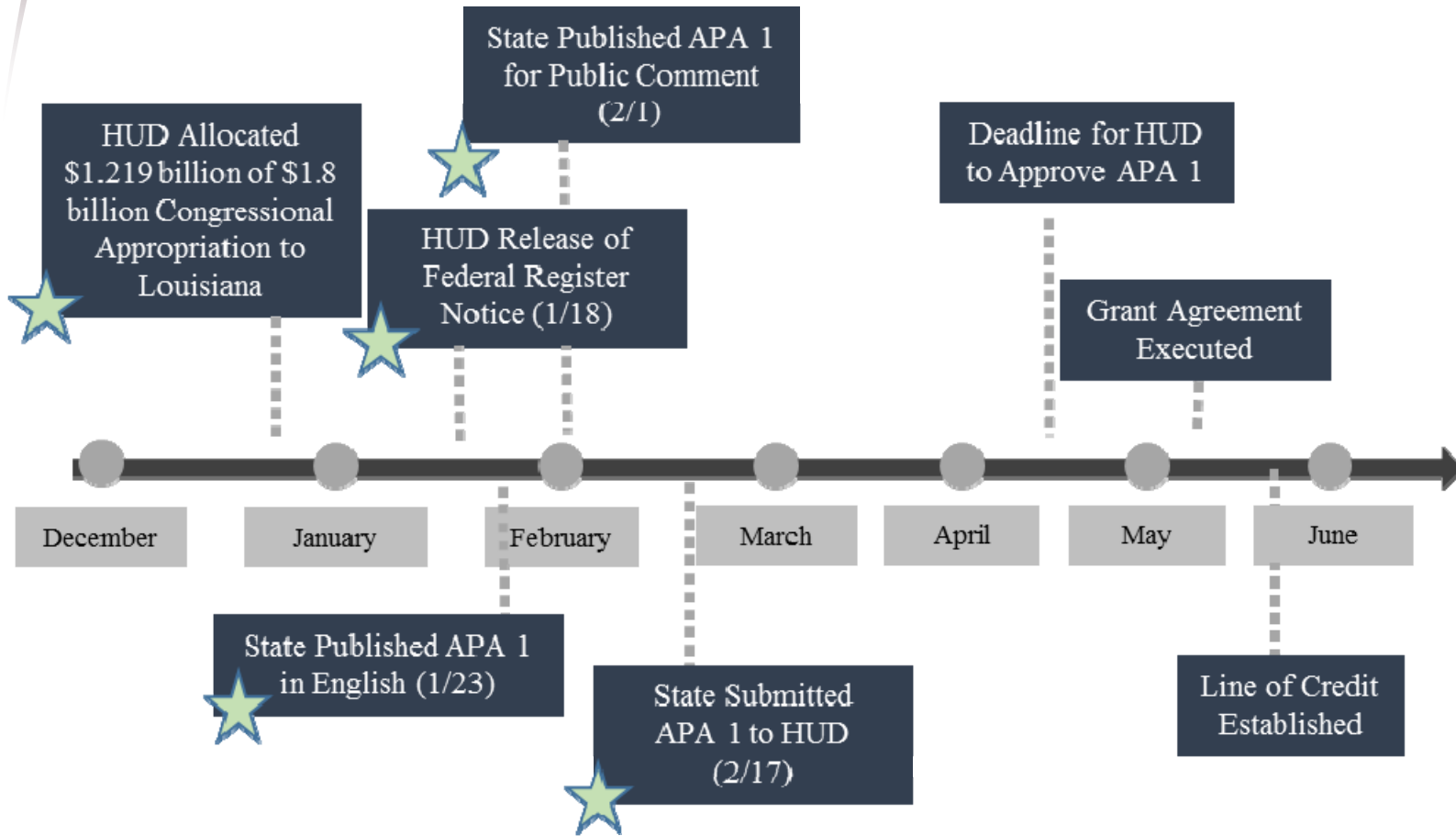


OCD-DRU Timeline: \$437,800,000



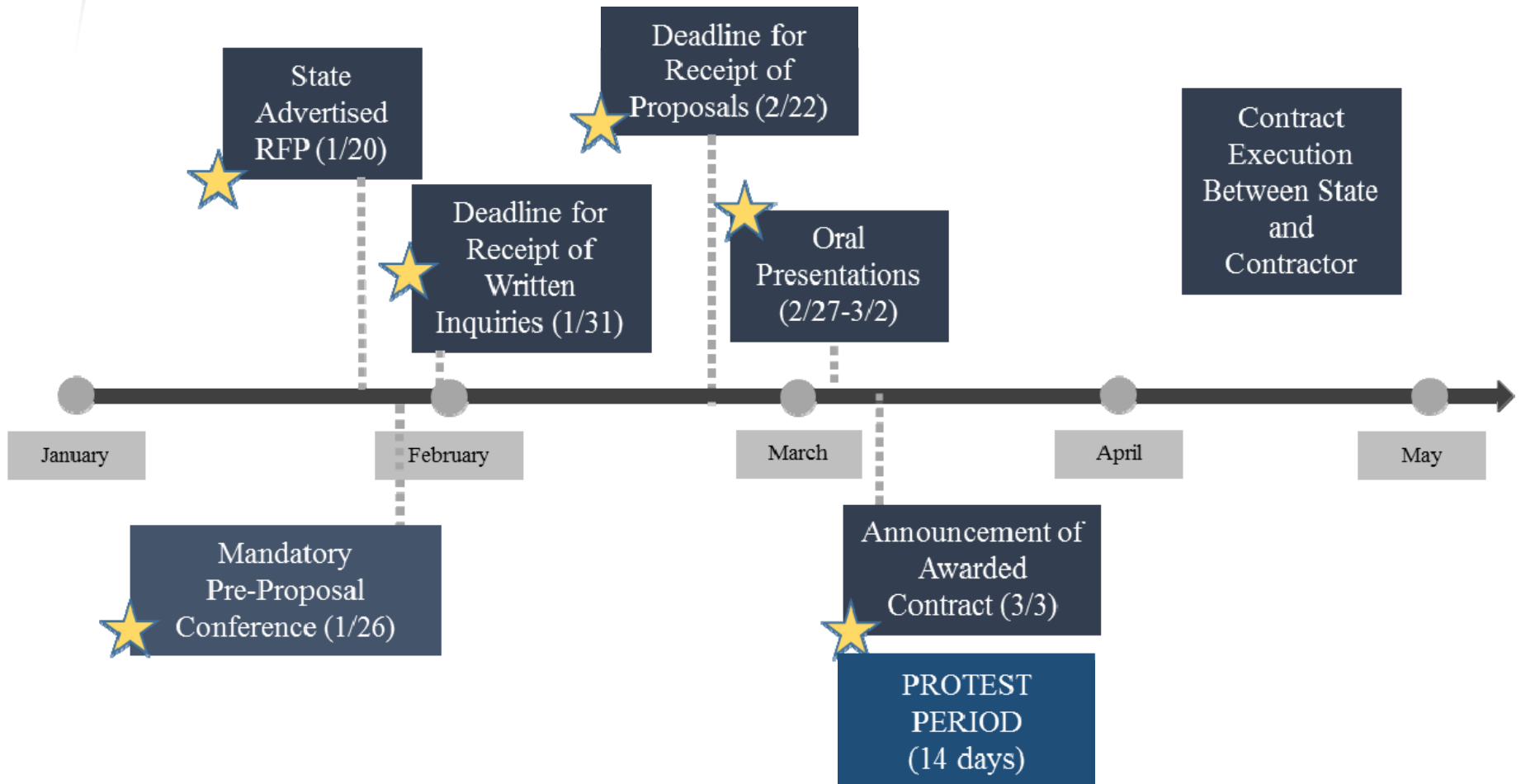


OCD-DRU APA 1 Timeline: \$1,219,172,000



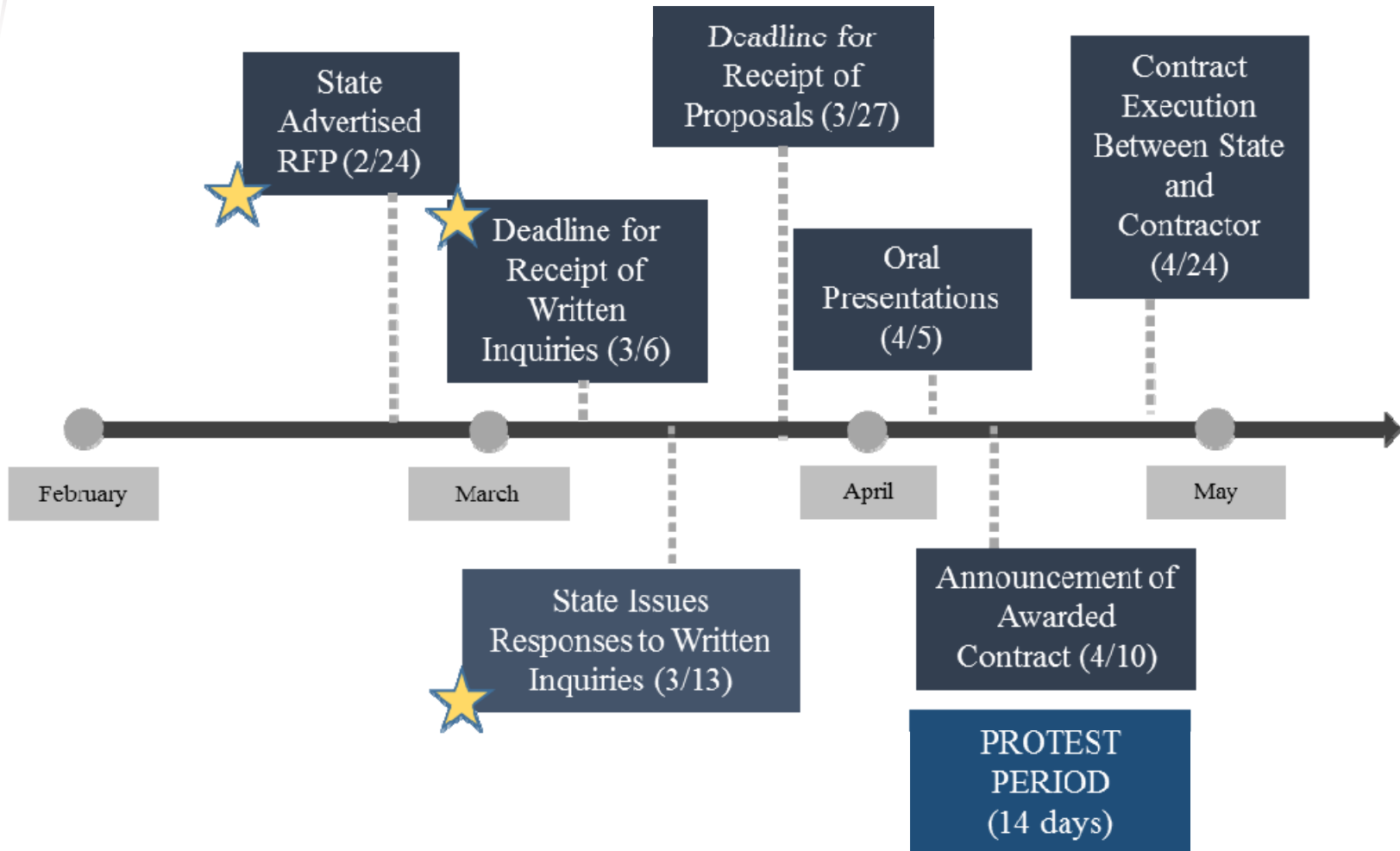


Homeowner Program Manager RFP



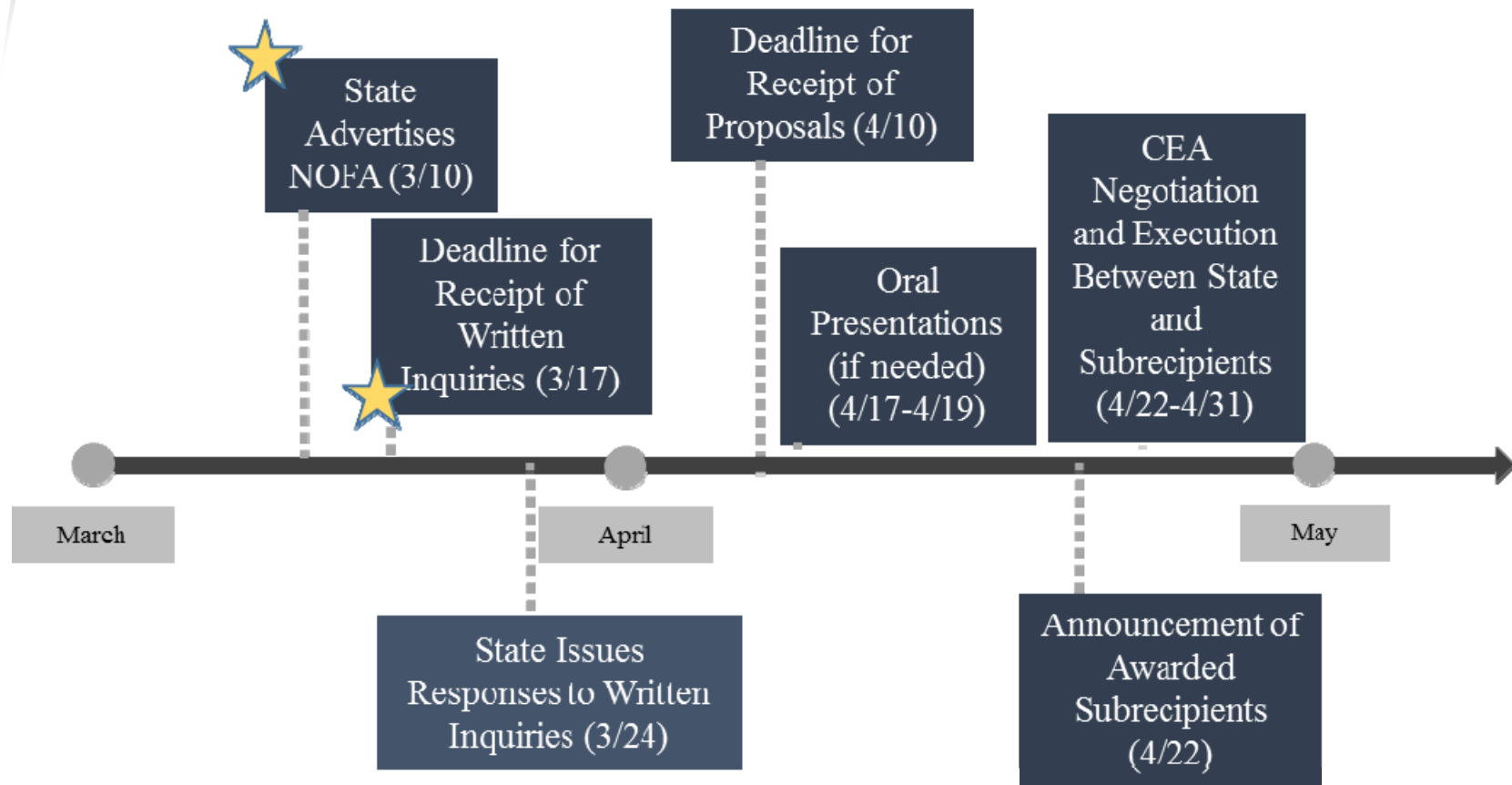


Homeowner QA/QC RFP



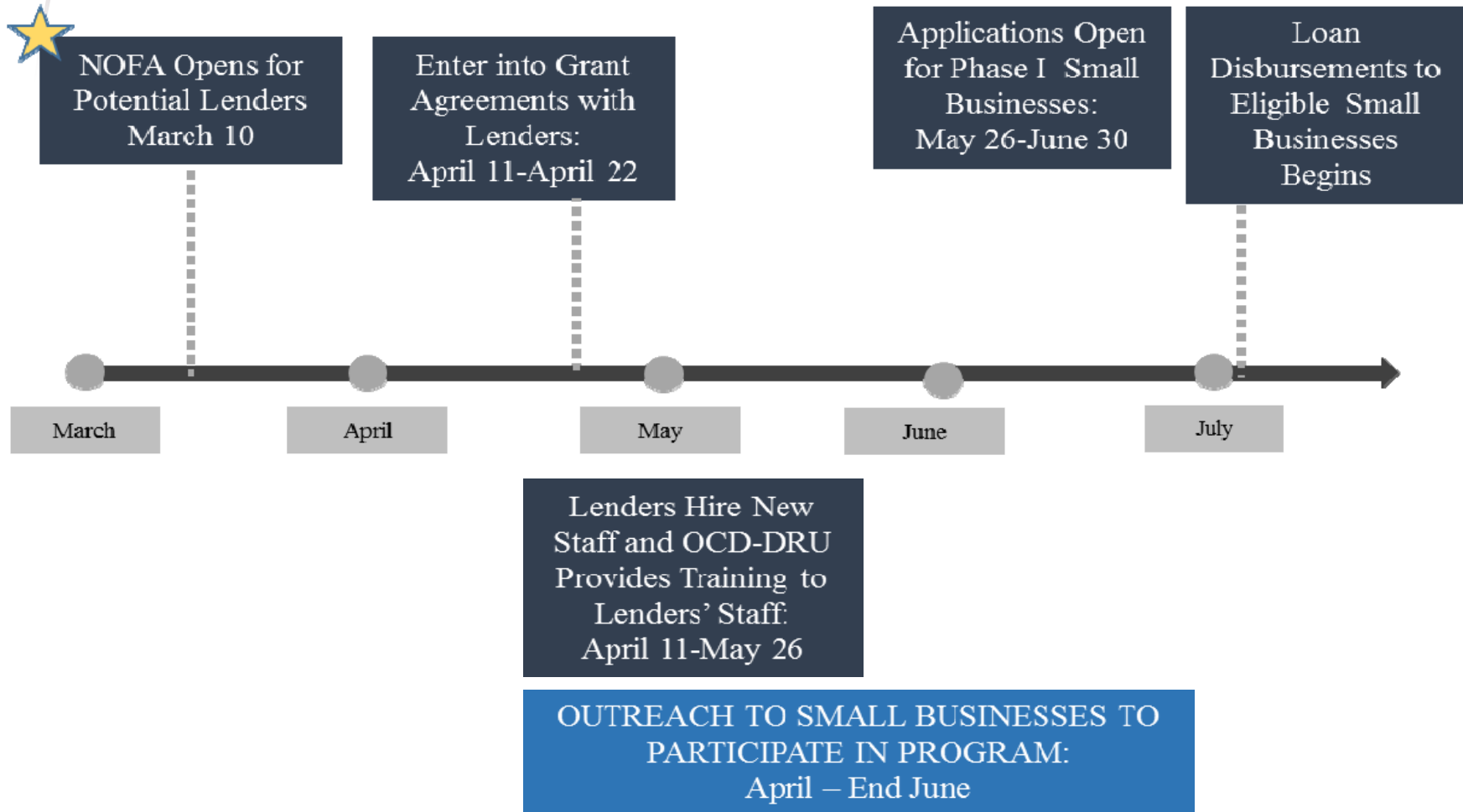

Restore Louisiana Small Business Program

- **Lender Eligibility Criteria:**
 - Non-Profits
 - Community Development Finance Institutions
 - Credit Unions
 - Track record and/or capacity to provide loans to small businesses
 - Has established offices in Louisiana

Restore Louisiana Small Business Program

- **Small Business Program Eligibility Criteria:**
 - Small Businesses and Non-Profit Organizations
 - 1-50 Full Time Employees
 - Minimum \$25,000 annual gross revenues (pre-flood)
 - Was operating at the time of the flood event
 - Has an eligible unmet need, after accounting for DOB
 - Experienced either a financial or physical loss as a result of one of the 2016 flood events
 - Phase I: Essential Services: gas stations, locally owned restaurants, daycares, healthcare providers, grocery stores, etc.



Restore Louisiana Small Business Program

➤ **Eligible Uses of Funds:**

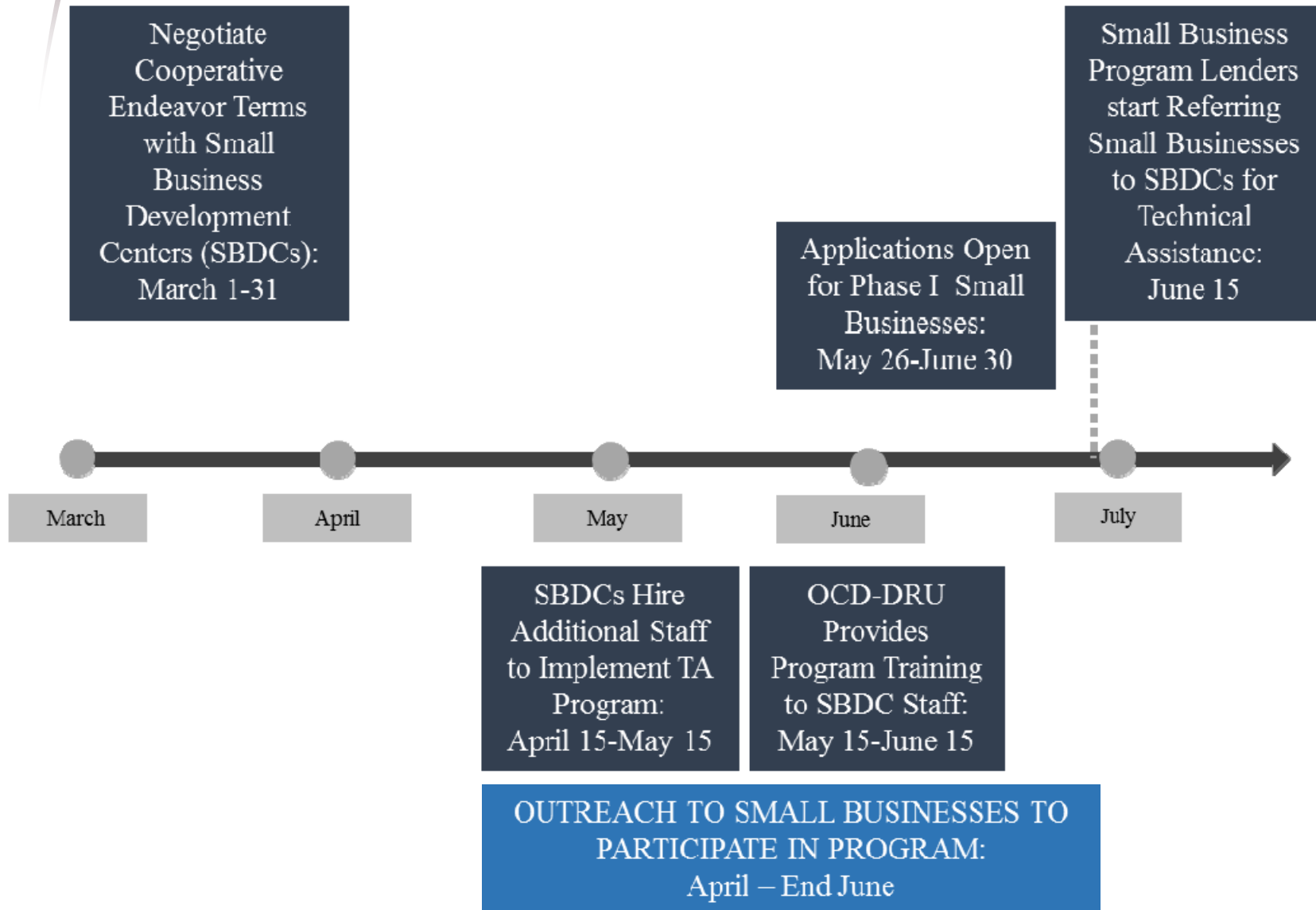
- Working Capital (rent/mortgage, utilities, non-owner employee wages, inventory)
- Movable Equipment
- Construction-related expenses are NOT eligible

➤ **Award Structure:**

- Up to \$50,000 loan for eligible unmet needs
- 80% repayable; 20% forgivable
- 0% Interest
- Up to 5 years repayment term

Restore Louisiana Small Business TA

- **Implemented by regional Small Business Development Centers**
- **Will provide Technical Assistance small businesses:**
 - Business Recovery and Continuity Plans
 - Financial Projecting and Planning
 - Disaster Preparedness Planning
- The Small Business Loan Program will refer businesses to Small Business Development Centers for Technical Assistance



Louisiana Farm Recovery Grant Program

- **Implemented by Louisiana Department of Agriculture and Forestry**
- **Provides grants to approved farmers who experienced 2016 crop or livestock losses**
