

The Louisiana Governor's Office of Homeland Security and Emergency Preparedness (GOHSEP) has partnered with FEMA's Mitigation Hazard Performance Analysis (HPA) professionals to perform watershed assessments for the watersheds affected by the March and August Flooding. Information gathered during this effort will be used to develop HMGP funding strategies as well as strategies to rebuild and sustain Louisiana Resiliency.

Your parish may be included in an affected watershed and we would like to invite you to be an integral part of the Watershed Assessment. We are extending invitations to Floodplain Managers, Public Works, Building Officials, Emergency Managers, designated Parishes and Regulatory Officials for an initial introduction to the Watershed Study and proposed activity that will ultimately be beneficial to recovery, local planning and development.
