

EXECUTIVE DEPARTMENT PROCLAMATION NUMBER 14 JBE 2018

STATE OF EMERGENCY – WINTER WEATHER

WHEREAS, the Louisiana Homeland Security and Emergency Assistance and Disaster

Act, La. R.S. 29:721, et seq., confers upon the Governor of the State of Louisiana emergency powers to deal with emergencies and disasters, including those caused by fire, flood, earthquake or other natural or manmade causes, in order to ensure that preparations of this state will be adequate to deal with such emergencies or disasters and to preserve the

lives and property of the people of the State of Louisiana;

WHEREAS, when the Governor determines that a disaster or emergency has occurred,

or the threat thereof is imminent, La. R.S. 29:724(B)(1) empowers the Governor to declare a state of emergency by executive order or

proclamation, or both;

WHEREAS, on January 16, 2018, a strong cold front moved into and across the state

causing freezing precipitation and low temperatures;

WHEREAS, the freezing temperatures have caused major road closures throughout the

state; and

WHEREAS, the weather forecasts predict another hard overnight freeze on January 17,

2018 across the state with little opportunity for roads to defrost during the

day.

NOW THEREFORE, I, JOHN BEL EDWARDS, Governor of the State of Louisiana, by virtue of the authority vested by the Constitution and the laws of the State of Louisiana, do hereby order and direct as follows:

SECTION 1: Pursuant to the Louisiana Emergency Powers Act, La. R.S. 29:721 *et seq.*,

and more specifically, La. R.S. 29:724, a state of emergency is hereby

declared to exist statewide.

SECTION 2: The Director of the Governor's Office of Homeland Security and

Emergency Preparedness is hereby authorized to undertake any activity authorized by law which he deems appropriate in response to this

declaration.

SECTION 3: All departments, commissions, boards, agencies and officers of the State,

or any political subdivision thereof, are authorized and directed to cooperate in actions the State may take in response to the effects of this

event.

SECTION 4: This order is effective upon signature and shall remain in effect from

Wednesday, January 17, 2018 until Friday, Febuary 16, 2018, unless

terminated sooner.
