



Two-week incidence by region








Cases on the rise in Region 1 (New Orleans)






Cases on the rise in Region 2 (Baton Rouge)






Cases on the rise in Region 3 (South Central)






Cases, hospitalizations on the rise in Region 4 (Acadiana)






Cases, hospitalizations on the rise in Region 5 (Southwest)






Hospitalizations on the rise in Region 6 (Central)






Cases on the rise in Region 7 (Shreveport/Bossier)






Cases, hospitalizations decreasing in Region 8 (Monroe)






Cases on the rise in Region 9 (Northshore)
